

A Smith Family of Loudoun County Virginia

George Dulin Smith, born 22 Sep 1804

- Son of William Smith and Hannah Dulin (dau Wm Dulin & Mary Wren), who married 20 Sep 1803 Loudoun VA.
- Mentioned in 1812 will of William Dulin (maternal grandfather) as being excluded from his (Dulin's) will because he had been amply provided for in his (George D. Smith) father's will.
- Mentioned in 1814 will of Mary Wren Dulin (maternal grandmother).
- Married Martha Lovett Gregg (daughter of George Gregg and Priscilla Clarke) 09 Aug 1831, Loudoun county Virginia. Martha Lovett Gregg Smith (b. 31 Jul 1814) died on 11 Jul 1871, buried Union cemetery.
- Listed in 1840, 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880 censuses of Loudoun county VA.
- Died 11 April 1881, buried Union cemetery, Leesburg, VA.
- Left a will in Loudoun county VA.

To this union were born 8 children:

- William D. Smith, b. 1832, Loudoun VA
- Eugenia Clarke Smith, b. 1835, d. 30 Jun 1897 Anadarko, Indian Territory, m. Frank Lee Fred on 12 Oct 1887, buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA (See 1)

- Annie P. Smith, b. 1837, d. 21 May 1883, also married Frank Lee Fred (aft. 1880), buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA
- George W. Smith, b. 22 Feb 1840, Loudoun VA, d. 06 May 1905, Bryan, Brazos, TX, buried Bryan Cemetery, Bryan, TX (See 2)
- Edgar Lovett Smith, b. 15 July 1842, Loudoun VA, d. 20 Jan 1874, St. Louis, MO, a physician, buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA
- Charles H. Smith, b. 1844, Loudoun, VA, d. 07 Jul 1899 in Anadarko, Indian Territory; buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA
- Zachary T. Smith, b. 1847, d. 1909, buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA.
- Martha Smith, b. 15 May 1849, Loudoun, VA, d. 14 May 1909, married Frank Lee Fred ca Apr 1900, buried Union Cemetery, Leesburg, VA.

1) Eugenia Clarke Smith, Annie P. Smith, *and* Martha Smith all are listed as having married Frank Lee Fred, who moved from Loudoun VA to Indian Territory after the civil war and was also a business partner

with Charles H. Smith. Frank Fred outlived them all, dying in 1916.

2) George W. Smith's tintype photo was in the album of Rachel Jane Smith Ramsey (the daughter of Francis Smith and Fanny Gray) of Fayetteville TN. No relationship has been established between the family of George

Dulin/George W. Smith and Francis Smith, but the photograph was in a family photo album owned by Rachel Smith Ramsey.
